Contact Reps Today to Oppose Calendar Bargaining Ban



A bill to prohibit school calendar and schedule as a bargaining topic is expected to move from a state House committee this week - it's time to contact your state representatives, and get parents and other interested community members involved in the fight.

House Bill 4163 removes local control of an educational issue that parents care deeply about. Educators on the frontlines know what their communities need in terms of calendar and schedule.

We've won this fight before-our calls and emails helped to stop this same measure from advancing to a House vote last year. Now the House Education Reform Committee has scheduled a vote on Thursday to send the measure for full House consideration.

Please contact your state representative today to say educators are the experts on the front lines, and we know what our students and communities need in terms of calendar and schedule.

The bill is scheduled for a committee vote today! MEA anticipates it passing out of committee, which is why we are focused on ensuring enough GOP opposition to it passing once it gets to the floor.

Here are the activities and asks we're making at this time:

- 1) Have members (as well as parents, neighbors, friends, etc.) contact state representatives to urge opposition to HB 4163. We've set up an Action Network page to facilitate sending emails (<https://actionnetwork.org/letters/protect-local-control-over-school-calendars>).
- 2) Please work with administrators and school board members to have them directly contact state representatives and urge that they oppose this. Talk about how administration and the union have used the bargaining process to solve schedule issues.
- 3) We are launching patch through calls in targeted districts – these are where members get a call and, if they're interested, can be connected directly to their state rep's office to urge opposition to the bill. We're also setting up some digital advertising to drive contacts to representatives about this bill.

Please look out for updates, and thanks for everything you can do to help fight this bill. Remember – we successfully stopped this bill last year, so actions like those above matter in our ability to do it again.
